No person is available to discuss this issue with me, even after already having three boil water advisories in less than two months time. There has been no announcement made of this current issue, nor has there been any advisory to not drink the water. This has not been addressed or even acknowledged by the city. My neighbor has been having the same issue, and she has also not received any answers, acknowledgement, or regard for her lack of safe drinking water. I have bottled some of the tap water and plan on contacting the local college to request an analyses. I will provide a photo at your request. It is disgusting and they are not even informing the citizens that it is happening.
