Thanks Jordan.

I did check on the set aside money issue. The state currently uses most of the set aside available to us to pay for staffing in the drinking water program. A small portion of it is used for wellhead protection grants. We don't have any additional set aside that could be used specifically for Flint without impacting other important drinking water programs. The technical assistance that we have been providing to Flint is through a \$300,000 general fund appropriation. This money is being used to pay for the Genesee County Health Department staff to test the drinking water in schools. In addition, it will pay for our full time Flint Water coordinator who is coordinating the efforts between the State and City and is spending most of his time currently reviewing protocols and meeting with Flint officials.
