 We do have a "Provider" field for each test. The "Provider" listed can be a health department, a doctor, a clinic or a hospital.

We can definitely distinguish whether a test was done by GCHD or someone else. Of the non-GCHD records, anything passing through the Hurley system seems to have Hurley marked as the provider. I'll have to go back and look regarding McLaren and others.

And yes, we can identify which tests are for Medicaid recipients.
