Kathy-- as I mentioned to you during our phone conversation, MDHHS is working closely with Genesee County Health Department to coordinate the public health actions in response to lead exposure from in Flint water system. MDHHS actions are focused on four main areas:

- Water filter/replacement cartridge distribution
- Lead testing in children 0-6 (that are exposed to Flint water supply)
- Nursing Case Management of Children with levels 5 micrograms/dl or higher
- Environmental assessment in the homes of children with elevated lead levels

The majority of children in Flint have Medicaid as their health care coverage, and receive support through other MDHHS programs including WIC. We greatly appreciate your efforts to update the Medicaid Health Plans and stay up to date on current strategies and communications. To that end, it would be beneficial to add a representative(s) from Medicaid to the MDHHS internal team meetings which occur every Thursday 12:30PM. We will be focusing on enhancing strategies to increase lead testing in children 0-6, so an individual (or individuals) with understanding of Medicaid data and knowledgeable about plan and provider based incentive strategies would be helpful. We can discuss further when we meet next Wednesday. Thank you.
