There was a CSTE call on MERS-CoV yesterday with a short summary of the Korean outbreak. I do not think CDC is getting a huge amount of information from WHO/Korea yet beyond # of cases, median/mean age, and that most cases had a health care exposure (patient, healthcare worker, visitor). The case fatality rate was ~ 10 percent although it could go up as time passes. The 10th case died today, although the CDC HAN that came this afternoon says nine. The index patient in Korea had a travel history to several Gulf states.

We will be getting a HAN out on MERS, hopefully this evening. I've attached the CDC HAN that has a little bit of information on the Korean outbreak.
