Effective today, the Population Health & Community Services
 Administration (PHCSA) will implement the attached organizational

 Prevention and EPI (BDCPE). In addition, I am designating Linda
 Dykema, Division of Environmental Health Director, as the Project
 Manager. (Note: this change applies to PHCSA only- Director Lyon
 maintains overall accountability for the MDHHS Flint Water Action Plan,
 and GERALYN Lasher is the point of contact for communications with the
 Governor's office.)

The organization structure further designates HHS staff as leaders for
 specific activities. If you are designated as a Group Leader, you will be
 receiving requests from Linda for information and for daily reports of
