My edits include:

1. We open by saying this letter is from six different organizations but I am waiting to talk to Rashmi as soon as she is out of her meeting to get a better sense of who are the signatories on the letter.
2. I think in the "Where does Lead Come From?" question you need to expand on the "Elevated levels of lead have been found in the drinking water in Flint." line to explain how it is leaching from some remaining lead pipes. Jennifer—you may have language here they can use.
3. In the What can I do to keep my family safe section, under the Protecting your family from lead in the water—on your cooking or washing dishes bullet point, do you mean to say you have to run the water for five minutes if using "unfiltered" water?" Also in this section you say "call for info on free filters" but do not say "You should only be using filtered water" in the homes, etc. You need to beef that up.
4. In the "Good Nutrition" section you need to say something about how to properly wash your fruits and vegetables. Should you only be using filtered water for this?

5. On the "Where should I go to get a blood lead test for my child?" question I am not certain why we are directing people to 211 if they don't have a physician. We should be directing them, with contact information, to the Genesee County Health Department.

Rashmi—looking forward to speaking with you soon because we also need to discuss the Sharepoint site.
