Dear Colleagues,

Many of you contributed to various aspects of the Flint water situation in recent weeks/months. In particular, Dr. Mona Hanna-Attisha and her "Flint Lead INvestigation Team" have provided data and advocacy leading to significant steps toward addressing the problem. As is often the case, however, there is more involvement by MSU-affiliated people than anyone of us knows. Moreover, there is significant opportunity for enhanced involvement by experts from both the College of Human Medicine and MSU Extension.

Please be reminded that we have a meeting scheduled for Friday, November 6, from 8 – 10 am in Room 132 at the MSU Flint Building, 200 East First Street, Flint. Coffee and light refreshments will be provided. The primary objectives for this meeting are to (1) become aware of what other MSU folks are doing related to this issue; (2) summarize the issue from multiple perspectives and review expert programs that are (or may be) influential; and (3) explore possible "next steps" for collaboration and intervention. Please come prepared to describe your involvement/expertise and participate in small group discussions.
