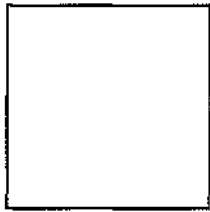

EarthTec is NSF 60 certified for drinking water and has been approved by the state of Michigan. We used EarthTec in Saginaw, MI for a few years until they changed their source water and no longer needed it. Pricing for EarthTec is \$15.00/gallon in 275 gallon totes FOB our plant in Holdrege, NE. We have a number of plants using EarthTec around the US for river water applications for both organics and algae.
