Jackson Citizen Patriot is still interested in Industrial Steel Treatment aftermath (fine, spill prevention improvements);

RRD is working on getting access to do Statewide Expanded Triage at old leaking underground storage tank sites;

WRD, RRD, and ODWMA-RLF Section are working with Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority (YCUA) and other stakeholders in Willow Run on plumbing upgrade issues and potential draw-down of impoundment at Tyler Pond/Tyler Dam NOAA Great Lakes Stickers;
