Action Step #6 – Mike Prysby reported that Flint and Genesee County are coordinating their efforts to have the unused portion of the 72-inch transmission main (pipeline) available for service. An Act 399 permit does not apply here; however, he plans to offer the DEQ's concurrence with their proposed procedure – provided that it references adherence to AWWA's disinfection standard and the sampling protocol that was discussed. Mike spoke with the city and the county today to confirm that actions are underway.

Action Step #3 – Pat Cook drafted the sampling instructions and they are under review by DHHS, EPA and DEQ staff.
