Action Step #6 – Mike Prysby reported that Flint and Genesee County are coordinating their efforts to have the unused portion of the 72-inch transmission main (pipeline) available for service. An Act 399 permit does not apply here; however, he plans to offer the DEQ's concurrence with their proposed procedure – provided that it references adherence to AWWA's disinfection standard and the sampling protocol that was discussed. Mike spoke with the city and the county today to confirm that actions are underway.

Action Step #3 – Pat Cook drafted the sampling instructions and they are under review by DHHS, EPA and DEQ staff.

Action Step 1. Preliminary list completed, circulated to HHS, and has been provided to DLARA to begin plumbing assessments. The list will remain active in case of additional schools requesting assessment/testing. (COMPLETE)

Action Step 2. See Item 1. DLARA to coordinate with Flint Schools on access for Plumbing Assessments. Tap coding identification from EPA guidance to be provided to DLARA. (DLARA Inspectors ready)

Action Step 3. Preliminary comments received by voice mail from EPA. Need to discuss directly. (Incorporating comments from partners)

Action Step 4. DEQ comments provided to MDARD and draft forwarded to DHHS for their comments. (Comments provided to MDARD)

Action Step 6. Approve Flint Plan for waterline (Disinfection Complete, waiting for test results and completion of system flushing)

The city and the county flushed the pipeline beginning yesterday, the first set of samples for total coliform analysis were collected around 2:30am. Genesee County will be collecting their second sample for bacteriological analysis between 6 and 8pm.
