Mike,

I spoke with Brad this morning. We focused on soundbites for television. Here is our message for the media at today's event. I'll plan to give these remarks if called upon.

- Our Office oversees public water systems, such as the City of Flint, to ensure public health standards for drinking water are continually being met.
- Department staff have been working in partnership with the City on this project over the past year to ensure the City can provide a safe, adequate, and reliable supply of drinking water. We are here today to recognize the City for the culmination of their hard work and effort associated with this undertaking.
- Work on this project also serves the City's long term needs as it will continue to rely upon this water treatment plant once connected to the Karegnondi Water Authority. The Department will continue to oversee the City's water operations, just as it does for the over 1400 community water systems throughout the state and we look forward to continued successful partnership with the City.
