Ms. Tanner,

A summary of all lead and copper compliance samples for the City of Flint is attached (Flint lead-copper history.pdf). This compilation was just completed by DEQ staff based on our records. For easier reading we have color coded the lead sample results. Those in green are 15 parts per billion or less. Those in red are over 15 parts per billion. While the City has indicated difficulty in obtaining and keeping customer participants, you will note as we explained during our meeting that lead results vary both higher and lower for addresses where monitoring has been conducted multiple times. Please note that due to the large volume of data, this document has been formatted to print on 11x17 paper.
