Home tests:

July -- December 2014: City sent out 200 bottles, got 100 back. 90th percentile level was 6 ppb

Jan -- July 2015: City sent out 200 bottles, got 60 back. Apparently sent out more bottles and eventually got 69 samples. 90th percentile was 11 ppb.
