Can you please tell me if these are the filters that were donated by the United Way in conjunction with Home Depot and other local Partners? We were not included in the filter selection for those filters.

I can tell you that when I visited the filter distribution with Director Wyant I was able to chat with a gentleman from Home Depot. I did not want to open the box so that the filter could be given out, but the box I examined clearly indicated that it had been certified by NSF International. I then asked the gentleman very specifically if the filter was designed for lead removal and he informed me that it was in fact certified for lead removal.

I will see if DHHS has any additional information.
