First, is it the City's intent to continue to send homeowner samples to the Lab in batches? This is working exceptionally well and makes it much easier for the Lab to process Flint's homeowner samples. If possible I would like to maintain this practice until the homeowner testing program is complete. You guys are doing a great job on this!

The second item is more of a clarification. Businesses that wish to get their water tested should be directed to contact the DEQ Lab at (517) 335-8184. These businesses should get their sampling kits directly from the Lab and they will be responsible for the payment of these samples.

Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns regarding these two items. I'll be there in Flint tomorrow so if needed, I can also discuss this with you in person.
