Action Item #1

Weekly internal after action plan meetings are being held. The topics of discussion for the meeting held on 10/29/15 included a status update of the timeline of events. It was agreed that long term comprehensive timeline needed to be created but an outline written at a higher level was needed within the next week to present to the Governor's After Action Review Panel. Additional discussion topics included an internal evaluation of Act 399 as well as the Federal Lead and Copper rule to determine what if any actions were implemented incorrectly.

Action Item #4

Negotiations between the Genesee County Health Department (GCHD) and the DEQ have begun to set up a contract to utilize GCHD resources to conduct sampling of Schools within the Flint School District as well parochial schools, charters and other childcare facilities.

Action Item #8

The comments provided by EPA have been incorporated and DEQ has issued a construction permit for phosphate equipment.

Action Item #15

The final draft of the school sampling protocol has been written and is awaiting final review. This version of the protocol incorporates comments by EPA and will be used to sample at Eisenhower Elementary and Brownell STEM Academy on Saturday October 31, 2015. Experiences from the sampling of Freeman Elementary on Saturday October 24, 2015 were used to create the final draft and experiences from Eisenhower and Brownell will be used to determine if any further changes are required.

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
