This is an informational update and the Genesee County Health Department will provide these updates on a daily basis after 4 pm. We are asking all partners included in this email to provide any

pertinent updates **DAILY** to Hilda McShane by 2:00pm. If you have nothing new to share, please inform Hilda that you have no updates at this time.

- Mass Transit Authority is working with Flint Community Schools' Brownell/Holmes Academy to transport parents to the lead screening clinic on Thursday, November 12th. Pickups for families will be at both Freeman and Eisenhower elementaries.
- Lead clinic at Genesee County Health Department's Burton Clinic in partnership with McLaren Health Plan on 11/5/2015 tested 40 participants.
- Mark Valacak from the Genesee County Health Department shared information regarding DEQ's issued report regarding their Flint Community School's findings. The findings indicated that the source of the lead at Freeman Elementary was due to plumbing fixtures on water fountains.
- 100 water filters via Rep. Neeley were distributed at an event at Our Lady of Guadalupe church yesterday 11/9/15.
- UW has limited funds to help Flint residents with their water bills, but are limited to a onetime donation and based the donation is based on specific income criteria. DHHS has similar onetime giving criteria.
- The City of Flint will distribute water filters at city hall at the front entrance of city of hall and ask customer to complete DHHS forms. Distribution of water filters will continue until supplies run out or will continue when supplies are replenished.
