 Please withdraw GCHD's Freedom of Information Act request for Freeman Elementary School, Flint (FOIA 0731-16).

George, Thanks for following up with me. Just as a reminder, GCHD would like to assist MDEQ with collecting water samples at the Flint Schools and other locations within the City of Flint, as needed. I have confirmed staff availability and our finance department calculated \$92/hr. for reimbursement. GCHD staff are required to be paid overtime (1.5 x 92) 138/hr. when working outside the hours between 8-5pm. Please let me know if you would like our assistance.

Also, just as an FYI, I am having GCHD staff visit all Flint schools to confirm that consumption of water is being prevented.
