FLINT, MI — The Karegnondi Water Authority Board of Trustees chose existing members as its new leadership.

On Wednesday, Nov. 25, the board for the KWA voted for Greg Alexander as chairman and Jamie Curtis as its vice chairman. Alexander is the Sanilac County drain commissioner, and was the vice chairman for the past few years under former Flint Mayor Dayne Walling, who was the chairman. Curtis is chairman of the Genesee County Board of Commissioners.

Subject: Legionellosis Outbreak Investigation

Hello Team,

The executive summary regarding the Legionella outbreak is appreciated, but I don't know if there is consensus that it is over. We have been collaborating with our local, state and federal partners regarding the next steps and efforts to improve methods to obtain adequate clinical and environmental isolates.

Genesee County has had three confirmed Legionella cases, since the beginning of May 2015. The most recent cases on 6/1/15 and 6/2/15 have provided sputum samples to McLaren Hospital for analysis. We have discussed concerns regarding the hospitals' lack of success isolating the bacteria and MDCH and CDC have expressed interest to assist with the process.

Below is a brief summary of the recent cases.

Patient #1 MDSS 7117888505 Patricia Schaffer, 408 Sharon Dr. Flushing, MI 48433. Ms. Schaffer is 81 years old. She was admitted to McLaren Hospital on 4/18/15 and discharged on 4/29/15. She returned to McLaren on 5/4/15 and was diagnosed with Legionella. McLaren attempted, but was unable to collect an adequate respiratory specimen. Ms. Schaffer does not receive Flint water at her residence.

Patient #2 MDSS #7208825131 Robert Skidmore, 576 Melrose Ln., Mt. Morris, MI 48458. Mr. Skidmore is 84 years old. He was admitted to McLaren Hospital on 5/13/15 and discharged on 5/19/15. He returned to McLaren on 6/1/15 and diagnosed with Legionella. Mr. Skidmore does not receive Flint water at his residence.

Patient #3 MDSS 7202952890 Gradine Rogers, 2314 Barth Street, Flint MI, 48504. Ms. Rogers is 74 years old. She was admitted to Hurley Hospital on 2/8/15, and discharged on 3/1/15. Hurley Hospital receives Flint water. Ms. Rogers went to McLaren on 5/29/15 and was diagnosed with Legionella. She resides approximately 2-3 miles North of McLaren Hospital. She receives Flint water at her residence. Her son, Dr. Antrick Johnson indicated that she has been ill since returning home from Hurley Hospital on 3/1/15. He also mentioned that there has been low water pressure events at their residence.

GCHD is prepared to collect environmental samples, as previously discussed, but without the clinical isolate the environmental samples may not have much value.

If there are recommendations, questions or concerns, please reply to the group, as we all have different roles with the investigation.
