FYI, I just spoke with Mr. Osborn. The impetus for the meeting, which is slated for tomorrow afternoon, is that the road through the Lapeer State Games Area is narrow (9-foot lanes) and the Lapeer County Road Commission (now) wants it widened to meet current standards (11-foot lanes plus shoulder). About 1,600 linear feet of roadway are under discussion.

If the entire expansion is into wetland, it would entail nearly ¼ of an acre of additional permanent wetland impact. However, any additional permanent wetland impact will require a new permit application. I will have more details after the meeting and will keep you in the loop. In the meantime, your thoughts are welcome.

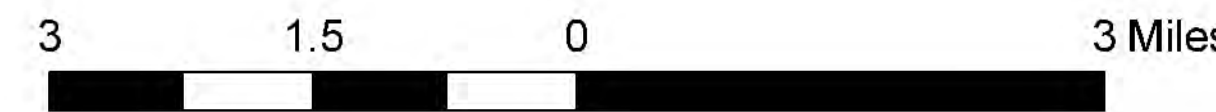
