Hi, Mike. Do you have a summary of water supplies available to residents in the neighborhood south of 3261 Flushing Rd, Flint, between Flushing and the Flint river? There is groundwater contamination in this area and some houses appear to still use residential water wells. One resident I talked to who lives on Hatherly Ave said they are connected to city water. But, the nearby house at 1457 Mitson Blvd still has a well. RRD Superfund section will be conducting an investigation of contamination in this area.
