> Hi Stephanie, please forward to the appropriate staff:

> I received a complaint that a new "water plant" (pump station?) constructed to serve the City of Flint pipeline from Lake Huron has a new discharge pipe running from the "plant" at the NE corner of Marathon and Stanley Rd (red circle on bottom of photo, Columbiaville, Lapeer Co) to the west along Stanley Rd, and discharging to Henry Drain (blue arrow). Since installation of the pipe in summer 2015, the quality of Henry Drain has been noticeably impacted. They claim it used to be very clear most of the time, but now it is dirty all the time and they won't go in it. They say the pipe from the "plant" discharges a dark liquid in both wet and dry weather.

> The caller was Leslie Dungey at 810-728-2650. Leslie's address is marked on the map, and she said you can come onto their property to look at the condition of Henry Drain where it crosses their property. One reason to take them up on their offer is that they have a bridge over the creek that is visible from an aerial closeup. I did not ask if they pulled a permit for the bridge.

Below are my comments on the Project Plan. We ask that you respond to (and/or resolve) these items by January 11th.

- #1) I understand the meter replacement map in Appendix B shows the municipalities where new meter installation will take place while the Figure 1-1 shows the actual service area for the county system. Will the entire DWRF project contain meter installation in all 10 townships (i.e. Clayton, Davison, Flint, Flushing, Gaines, Montrose, Mt. Morris, Richfield, Thetford and Vienna) where new meters will be installed? We need you to provide a map which not only shows the municipalities where new meter installation will take place for the entire DWRF project, but also identifies the locations of the proposed five (5) base stations for the entire DWRF project.
