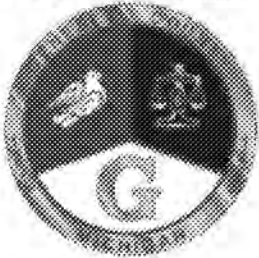
Patient #3 MDSS 7202952890 Patient #3 was admitted to Hurley Hospital. Approximately two months after being discharged, went to McLaren and was diagnosed with Legionella. Patient #3 resides approximately 2-3 miles North of McLaren Hospital and receives Flint water. A family member of Patient #3, indicated that illnesses lingered after returning home from Hurley Hospital and also mentioned that there has been low water pressure events at their residence.

GCHD is prepared to collect environmental samples, as previously discussed, but without the clinical isolate the environmental samples may not have much value.

As we enter summer (finally) here in Michigan, I wanted to share a summary of the analysis of the data around this past year's increase in legionella cases identified in proximity to the city of Flint. As you'll recall, while there were no clinical specimens available for testing from the 45 cases included in the investigation, there was a significant outreach to gather more patient information from cases.
