YourMessage: Hello, My mother and I are residents of City of Flint and there is a problem with the drinking water. It routinely smells like the sewer line has crossed into it, is colored instead of clear, and no longer smells like it has any chlorine in it at all. The city has had a problem with moving the water and issued three boil water advisories in 30 days. We did not find out about them because the announcement only went on the news instead of in an automated message and we don't have cable, so we don't generally watch TV. I am extremely concerned that the water is not clean when it actually reaches my home, irrespective of how clean it is when it leave the factory and I am not sure why this would be, since this was never a problem when the water was supplied by Detroit; it never smelled like the sewer and I could always smell the chlorine.
