We have until May 11th (one week from Monday) to submit our last modifications. Please note the address listed in the message immediately below this one that we should use to submit modifications by email next week because Druanne Cote will not be available to process ones sent to her address.

I have also attached a large file in excel that provides the updated status of all projects in Michigan. Some people find this format easier to sort and manipulate to identify the projects that may need possible modifications. If you have a lot of systems or a system with a lot of projects, you can cut and paste the data from your systems into a separate excel workbook and then sort on the comment code to see which projects may need attention. For instance, all projects with a code of 100 have been accepted unchanged and can be ignored. Projects that have a code of 308 were modified by Cadmus, but only to the extent that costs will be modified instead of using the cost estimate provided, so no further action is needed. You will find the codes on the opening page of the needs survey website.

As I look through this spreadsheet next week, I may be contacting some of you to discuss possible responses for systems that have a lot of deleted projects and for which you have not indicated any response or marked "satisfied" on the tracking spreadsheet. If I decide to submit modifications independently, I will copy you.
