Water Main Improvement Projects:

The City of Flint is proposing to commence with the construction of several new water main projects in the 2002, replacing water lines that are over 75 years old and to provide potable drinking water for service to existing and new developments/ land use and for fire protection. The projects in order of priority are:

Hamilton Avenue between Saginaw St. and James P. Cole Blvd
Ballenger Hwy between Augusta and the City Limits
Pierson Rd between Fleming Rd and Horton
Fifth Avenue between Prospect St and Chippewa
M.L. King Avenue between Pasadena and Flint Park Blvd
Fenton Rd between Hemphill Rd and Atherton Rd
East Court Street between Dort Hwy and Averill Ave.
Flushing Rd between Prospect and Ballenger Hwy
Third Ave between Chevrolet Ave and Saginaw Street.
