Hi Terri,

I know that Dawn Scharer has been in touch about the concerns of lead in the City of Flint's water, and the concern for the health of our clients. I met with some community partners yesterday (reps from the city, hospitals, United Way, Red Cross, etc). The United Way is saying that they have funds to provide filters for some of our clients, and can temporarily distribute water, as well. One of the asks of our health department was to provide addresses of WIC clients, so that Hurley can overlay this info on their maps that are showing high lead tests, along with the city's maps of the lead lines, to determine who is at highest need for filters.

My question is, is there any information that we can provide without breaching our client's privacy?
