I talked with Jennifer Eisner and here is what we agreed:

Only the 2014 data (not 2015 data) would be typewritten release a year's data before the year is completed. By a possible for all of Michigan with small cells suppressed. And only confirmed venous tests as CLPPP has done for previous years. We explain that we're including capillary tests in the final reports in an effort to capture all possible BLL data.
