Sue & Dr. Wells:

See the attached L Letter regarding blood lead testing for children in Flint. Note that on the FFS side, providers can bill the lead code with a quantity of 2 per day. A statement is included in the last paragraph to make it clear that testing according to the enhanced guidelines is covered under EPSDT. We are essentially reiterating information that has been provided through other means. The plan would be to send this out to providers in the Flint area zip codes.
