Hello Laura,

We have not received anything yet. I believe the request will come after a vote from the Genesee County Commission. I'm not sure when the commission is slated to meet next. Do you have a contact there?

Gov. Snyder remains committed to working with Mayor Weaver to get Flint residents the assistance they need. Flint residents deserve access to clean, safe water. We also are committed to protecting the health of Flint's children, both immediately and into the future.

As you know, leaders from the Michigan State Police Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division met with the mayor and commission chairman earlier this week to help them determine the best possible pathway to additional state and federal resources.

That assistance will be in addition to the \$10 million the state government has committed to Flint residents to help pay for the switch to the Great Lakes Water Authority water, free filters for all residents and additional testing, among other items in Gov. Snyder's action plan.
