The health and safety of our residents is always the first priority, and that includes ensuring clean, safe drinking water, especially for children. The state continues to work with Flint leaders on their water questions, including through Mayor Walling's technical advisory board. That board includes outside experts and studies data and offers recommendations. The Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Health and Human Services also are testing water and working with Flint residents on issues related to what they can do if they have concerns about the pipes in their homes.
