The City of Ecorse experienced three events in 2011 that resulted in a surplus in the general fund of \$1,049,706:

Issuance of Judgment levy	\$9,315,146
Receipt of Emergency Loan	\$2,000,000
Charge off of an Interfund Payable	\$5,364,984
Total	\$16,680,130

The judgment levy is for two more years. It was issued to pay other local units for property tax collections Ecorse "borrowed" rather than distribute to the other units. Joyce anticipates a balanced budget even after these one-time receipts expire.
