ORDER DISMISSING CASE

Plaintiff Adam Gerics filed the present case and claimed that the City of Flint violated the Constitution when it redrew the boundaries of the Carriage Town Historic District. On September 8, the parties stipulated that Gerics would have 14 days to submit a new complaint that conformed to the pleading standards contained in the Federal Rules. ECF No. 6. On September 18, Gerics filed a motion that requested additional time to respond. ECF No. 8. The Court granted the motion and gave Gerics until October 28 to file a new complaint that conformed to the Federal Rules. The order also stated that "[i]f the Court has not received a properly formatted complaint by that date, the Court will dismiss his case with prejudice under Civil Rule 41." ECF No. 10. October 28 has passed and Gerics has yet to file a corrected complaint. Accordingly, Gerics' case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
