- **Priorities:**
 - Water: City is looking to CDBG funding to purchase lead filters, Mayors initiative.
 - City has CDBG funding to the tune of \$400K, city will start within and use city resources before approaching the Mott Foundation.
 - Working with United Way – they are actively searching for funding.
 - VIEOLIA is finished the contract with the city. City has implemented the recommendations from VIEOLIA.
 - \$8.4M outstanding in billing. City cannot keep going on with this issue – state needs to help take some of the responsibility with us.
 - City Admin. argues Flint is a special case with Judge Hayman's order, lead issues, financial issues, etc...
 - Cash on hand: Finance department is estimating how long the city can operate with cash on hand, and what bills are and are not being paid (presentation will be made at the November RTAB meeting).
 - Council is requesting a special meeting on October 21 to have an open discussion regarding water issues. Letters will be sent to 75 individuals, including F. Headen.
 - City Admin. does not agree with the idea and believes it is micromanaging at best.
 - Budget amendments will be presented to Council next week – reduction in revenue for enterprise fund and removing capital improvement projects. Without being able to collect water bills, the city cannot go forward with CIPs.
 - Today is the deadline for the finance department's report required by Judge Hayman's Order.
 - A report was completed and submitted, it was determined not acceptable by attorney Val Washington, the city was then asked to re-submit the report.
 - Will be submitted by 5pm today.
- **KWA:** City Administrator said that they are still on track to hook up June 2016.
