I know that I'm a broken record on this one, but I need some specific attention to Flint today. I need you all to reconstruct a timeline of events from the records we have relating to the Flint KWA DWSD controversy as it is becoming unwieldy. Please go back and review the Flint procedures and find the initial decision making process relating to the switchover. The first time I remember it is in 2012 (August I think) when the county started pitching the project at council. Then we instituted Mike Brown as EM and from there on it became to a certain extent our problem. However, if I remember right, this was a Flint idea from the start. Then, if you can trace the financial drivers of the decision to present day it would be important. I think for the most part the explanation you had in the distressed cities reports were helpful...my point being that this was an idea to help the city survive and without drastic changes it wouldn't have, KWA being one of them. We'll take any other ideas that you have.

I couldn't find much.

The City of Flint has been participating with Genesee County on the feasibility of the City's use of a planned water pipe line from Lake Huron that would serve a large portion of Genesee County as an alternative to water supplied by DWSD. After entertaining numerous offers from DWSD, the EM announced on May 1, 2013 that the City will join the Karegnondi Water Authority.

January 2013- An engineering firm selected by Treasury to conduct an independent evaluation of Flint's choices for water supply presented their findings on December 18th. Flint's decision regarding their participation in the Karegnondi Water Authority must be finalized before mid-January 2013.

December 2012 - Treasury has selected an engineering firm to conduct an independent evaluation of Flint's choices for water supply; remaining with Detroit Water and Sewerage Department or participating in the proposed Karegnondi Water Authority.
