The only funding that we have specific to Flint is the funding that is provided to OFR. That would be the funding they are using for vendor services. We also could use FIT funding potentially if the Flint schools are also a part of the problem. The funding for that is overseen by Brian Carpenter for OFR and by Phil Trapp for FIT spending.

The only Flint specific funding that we ever got was in FY 15 for City of Flint Police and Fire Safety Grant. We got a one-time \$1.1 million grant for them. They were supposed to use the funding to hire new fire fighters and police officers. I do not believe that they actually hired additional staff but used this funding for existing staffing costs. In FY 16 we have nothing specific to it.
